Clinical Research Nursing is recognized by the American Nurses Association as a specialty practice. In Oct 2016, the *Clinical Research Nursing Scopes and Standards of Practice* were published. However, clinical research nurses are not new. In 1910, Nancy P. Ellicott was hired as the superintendent of nursing at the new Rockefeller Institute Hospital, the first center for clinical research in the United States. Her high standards for the role of nurses in the new field of clinical research served as the foundation for the specialty. This session will provide an overview of the 110-year evolution of clinical research nursing.
