Dr. Sabina Kaczanowska is a postdoctoral fellow in the Tumor Microenvironment and Metastasis Section of the Pediatric Oncology Branch at the NCI. She completed her doctoral dissertation work at the University of Maryland, Baltimore in 2016, focusing on tumor immunology and T cell immunotherapy. Dr. Kaczanowska's current research under the mentorship of Dr. Rosandra Kaplan is focused on the immune response to metastasis in pediatric sarcomas and the pre-clinical development of novel immunotherapeutic strategies for the treatment of solid tumors. Throughout her career, Dr. Kaczanowska has received numerous awards in support and recognition of her research and has published several peer-reviewed manuscripts and review articles in the field of cancer immunotherapy. Her scientific aspirations are to expand on our understanding of the mechanisms of tumor progression and metastasis and to contribute to the development of new therapies for the treatment of patients with cancer.
